

The investment objective of the Fund is to outperform the Morgan Stanley World Index over a full market cycle. The Fund invests in publicly listed companies located around the world that operate in our targeted environmental sectors and that we believe are trading at a discount to their future cash generation potential.

COMMENTARY

An historic 2008 came to an end with a benign December in which global indexes and the Fund each enjoyed gains. The Fund's 7.2% increase and relative outperformance were driven primarily by its largest holdings in European infrastructure stocks such as Siemens (up 27% for the month), ABB (up 16%), and Veolia (up 26%). These gains were in part due to Euro appreciation and in larger part due to enthusiasm about the prospect of the companies' participation in global governmental stimulus plans, a large component of which will be focused on infrastructure and efficiency. Looking forward to 2009, while we don't expect general economic conditions to improve materially, we do expect the trends supporting environmental sectors to grow in strength: the need for more efficient infrastructure, questions about long-term energy supply and security, global warming, and other environmental issues. Our fund is positioned to benefit from all of these trends.

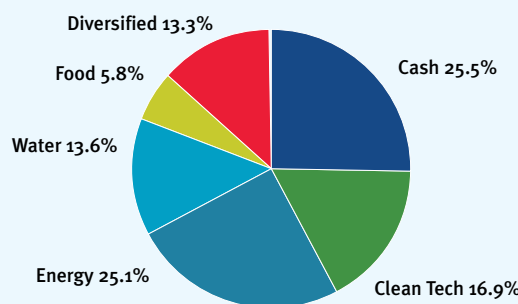

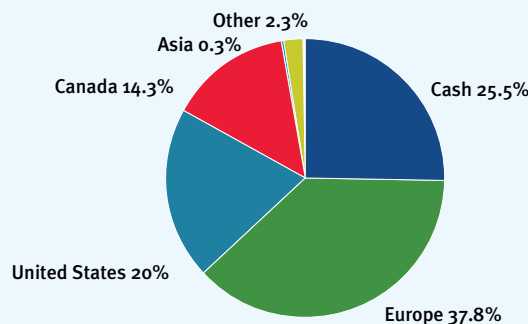

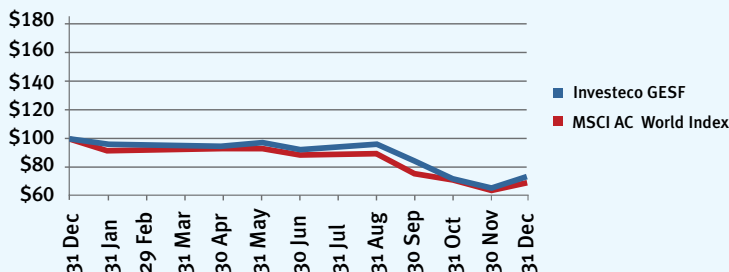
SECTOR ALLOCATION
